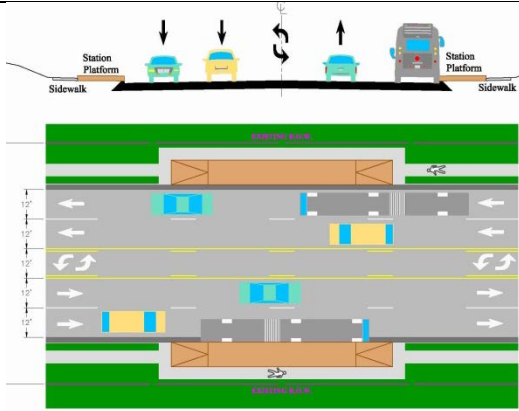




## North-South Corridor Study COMMENT CARD

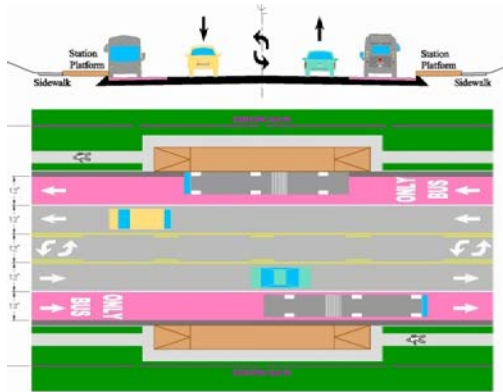

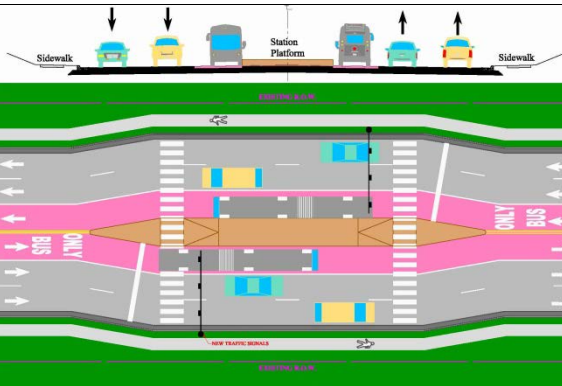
